


Doing the Dead

When booking tickets online a Booking Fee is charged per ticket. This is to cover the cost of processing the online booking. There is no charges when booking in person at the Box Office

Refunds

Tickets are not refundable unless a performance is cancelled. You will be given 4 weeks from the date you are informed to claim the refund.

Reserved tickets must be paid within 7 days of the reservation or they will be released for resale

Parking

In the interest of good neighbourhood relations. we ask that you refrain from parking on the streets surrounding the theatre but make use of the FREE PUBLIC CAR PARK located down Carlton Street, a short walk from the theatre

Accessibility Infomation

Due to fire safety reasons, wheelchair transfers are not permitted. The auditorium has a Sennheiser infra-red hearing enhancement system. The Box Office will advise you on which seating area suits your specific needs. A Limited number of headsets are available from the Box Office on payment of a £5 returnable deposit; they are easy to use but please arrive a few minutes early if you haven't used them before.
